Classroom Goal Calculation: Our goal is for the school to exceed \$13,000, which makes the goal per student approximately \$27. All classroom goals were set taking the number of kids in each class and multiplying by \$27. On the fundraising collection envelope, it is listed that the suggested minimum fundraising goal per student is \$35, this allows us to account for the impact of historical participation rates. During the Hop-a-Thon last year, our participation rate was 60%. With a \$35 minimum fundraising goal per student, that is planning closer to an 80% participation rate. Which we realize is far above our actual participation rates from last year, but we are working towards encouraging more students to participate and those students who compete for the top earners help us reach our goal as well.
