Legislative Update

Exciting times in legislative advocacy! The 2017 Legislative Convention was another inspiring event. So many people give countless hours of their time to ensure a broad range of issues impacting our children are brought to the forefront. On the education funding front, the Washington State Supreme Court heard oral argument on October 24 regarding whether the state has met its obligation to amply fund education. The Court has taken the matter under advisement. It is difficult to predict which way the Court will decide on this important issue, so many will be eagerly awaiting the Court's ruling.

PTSA and the Law

On October 11th the PTSA had 4 members (Amy Pitt, Karen Wright, Uli Staerk and Lindsey Tolson) attend a Washington State PTA led training class called PTA & the Law. Our membership chair, Carmen Love also took the class via a webinar in September. There are many rules and regulations to running a non-profit corporation, from the Secretary of State to the IRS. We are grateful to have the support and training from the state PTA level so that we can stay on top of all the rules. The sales tax section of the training gave us a good reminder about using our resellers permit when purchasing popcorn supplies since we are submitting an excise tax return in January (thus paying sales tax) for our monthly popcorn sales.
