The Green Team initiated milk carton recycling in all lunches, which saved about 30% of the total lunch waste. Last year The Kindergarten class planted a "salad garden," which consisted of kale, lettuce, peas, radishes, carrots and beets. The vegetables that were not consumed by the students were donated to a local food bank, which amounted to about 100 lbs.
