The legislative session will wrap up at the end of April. The bills associated with school construction and changing bond voting from a super majority to a simple majority have died for this year. Two bills addressing the teacher shortage are making better progress. SHB 1621, regarding alternatives to the teacher basic skills test and SHB 1139, regarding strategies to improve and incentivize the recruitment and retention of highly effective educators.
