CLASSROOM GOALS

Classroom Goal Calculation: Our goal is for the school to exceed \$14,000, which makes the goal per student approximately \$27. All classroom goals were set taking the number of kids in each class and multiplying by \$27. The suggested minimum fundraising goal per student is \$35, this allows us to account for the impact of historical participation rates. During the Hawk Walk last year, our participation rate was about 68%. With a \$35 suggested minimum fundraising goal per student, that is planning closer to an 77% participation rate.
