Stillwater PTSA Hop-a-Thon Assembly - Activity Sign-Up

Great news! Stillwater Elementary reached its fundraising goal of \$11,000 for the Hop-a-Thon, so we will have a spirit assembly on Wednesday, Dec 7th at 2:50PM to celebrate. We'll be playing Hungry Hippos and Egg Head at the spirit assembly. Review each section below for more details, and then use the sign-up portion at the end to sign-up for a chance to play one or both. **Sign-ups are due by the end of school on Wednesday, November 30th** and the **winners will be announced on Friday, December 2nd** at which time <u>parents will need to confirm participation via the email provided on this form</u>.

Egg Head: Egg Head is a game where each contestant takes turns selecting an egg from a carton of 12: some are hard boiled and some are raw. Once the egg is selected, the contestant smashes it on their own head. Whoever smashes 2 raw eggs on their head first loses the game. Mr. Madigan will play Egg Head with a few students/staff that enter for a chance to face him and the eggs. The PTSA will be supplying students with safety goggles to wear during the game and paper towels/baby wipes to clean-up after. Parents of students participating can attend and bring extra clothes if desired.



Hungry Hippos: During Hungry Hippos, students will be laying on their belly on a floor roller and using an upside down laundry basket to collect ball pit balls from a central location and bring back to their teams' corner until the time runs out. 1st Session – 4 teams (8 students) within grades K-2 competing, and 2nd Session - 4 teams (8 students) within grades 3-5 competing. 12 of



the Students will be Top Earners, the remaining 4 will be randomly selected based on this sign-up. For grades K-2, a staff member will be holding the legs of the students to move them forward towards the balls. For grades 3-5, we will give the students the option to hold each others legs or have a staff member do it. We ask that you please visit our website, www.stillwaterptsa.org/hopathon and view the Hungry Hippos video to provide a visual on how the game works before you sign-up. ALL HUNGRY HIPPO PLAYERS MUST WEAR A HELMENT THAT THEY BRING TO SCHOOL. The PTSA does not have helmets to loan.
