

OBSTACLE COURSE RELAY CHALLENGE – PERMISSION SLIP

Event Date: Thursday, June 6th | All-School Assembly

We're excited to announce a K–5 Obstacle Course Relay Challenge during our all-school assembly on Thursday, June 6th! This fun and active event will feature randomly selected students from each grade, chosen from those who donated to our fundraiser.

Relay Breakdown:

- **Kindergarten–2nd Grade:** One student at a time will do an army crawl and pass a baton to the next teammate until their group is finished.
- **2nd Grade hands off the baton to 3rd Grade.**
- **3rd Grade:** Students will keep a balloon in the air while picking up 10 balls and placing them in a bucket. When done, they pick up the baton and pass it to a 4th grader.
- **4th Grade:** Repeats the same balloon/ball challenge as 3rd grade.
- **4th Grade then passes the balloon and baton to the 5th grader.**
- **5th Grade:** The final leg! The 5th grader will bounce the balloon through a series of hula hoops held by teammates, racing to the finish line.

The first team to complete the full relay wins!
