Mr. Madigan's updates

- Mr Madigan expressed gratitude for REF grants to fund the 5th grade camp.
- Our teachers have been working very hard to become a Professional Learning Community (PLC) school. SWE applied and just got approved as a School of Promising Practice, a big achievement.

VOTE: The members voted to endorse the bond - motioned and passed.

Guest speaker: Dr. Leach and Bond Committee

- Dr. Leach shared a presentation about the Bond Levy process.
- Proposition #3: The state does not fund building schools, the community needs to raise money. Includes Tolt Middle school rebuild, HVAC systems for all schools.
- Proposition #1: Bridge the gap between state funding and what students need. For example, the state only funds 3.5 out of 5 librarians in our school district.
- Proposition #2: technology
- Why rebuild Tolt Middle School? Tolt Middle school was built in the 1970s, in very poor shape, consists of 87 exits, 11 separate buildings that raised security

concerns. It is getting more costly to repair and maintain than building a new school.

- Dr. Leach presented the plan with the Tolt Middle School rebuild.
- Projects were decided by a Capital Asset Advisory Committee formed 2 years ago - all community members, no staff.
